## Guidelines on filling in Table A of the Learning Agreement for Erasmus+ incoming students

The sending and receiving institutions are required to enter into a "learning agreement" with the student before the beginning of the period of study. In essence, in the Learning Agreement the programme for the study period is described; it stipulates the learning objectives for the study period during your time with us.

In Table A please enter the modules which you would like to take during your Erasmus+ time with us. The basis for this is always the curriculum of the course in which you will study with us in the Erasmus+ framework. The curricula can be found at http://website.musikhochschule-muenchen.de -> Studium -> Studienmöglichkeiten at the University of Music and Performing Arts Munich under the links for the individual courses (e.g. Flöte -> Studium -> Bachelor of Music - künstlerische Studienrichtung -> Studienplan).

You may only attend modules which are listed in the curriculum for your course. Please note here in particular the difference between Bachelor and Master's degrees and between 'künstlerisch' (performance) and 'künstlerisch-pädagogisch' (performance-pedagogical) courses. (Erasmus+ students are usually enrolled in 'künstlerisch' (performance) courses.)

For the individual modules please enter the exact number of **ECTS points** which the curriculum stipulates for the successful completion of the respective module. The ECTS points are given in the curriculum in a grey column in each case.

When you are studying at our University, you must achieve the number of ECTS points in the **main subject** as stipulated for the respective semester.

In **all other subjects** you are not restricted in your choice of modules. You can also choose modules which are intended for other semesters in the curriculum.

Please inform yourself about the possibilities in the **elective modules** of your course via our University portal eCampus (<a href="https://ecampus.musikhochschule-muenchen.de">https://ecampus.musikhochschule-muenchen.de</a>) or via our Adviser for Curriculum-Related Matters, Frau Vollert-Horch (<a href="ruth.vollert-horch@hmtm.de">ruth.vollert-horch@hmtm.de</a>). Please note that participation in modules in the elective module cannot be guaranteed, as this is dependent upon the capacity of the respective module.
